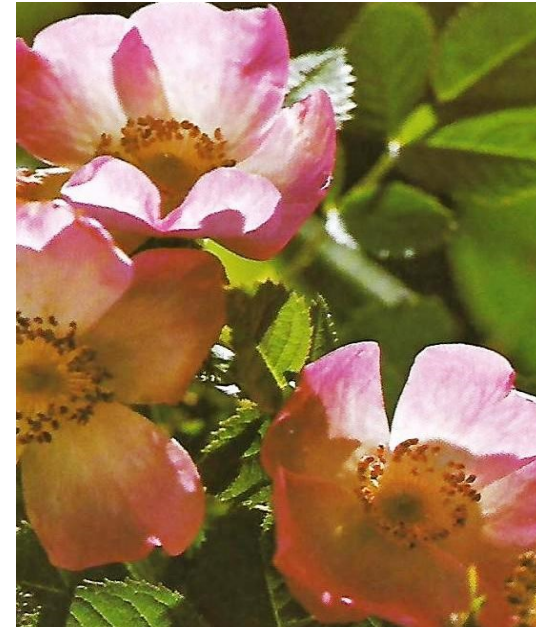
St. Cybi's Stewarding Team—Spring and Summer 2016

Saints Days April 2016

23: St George: He was probably a soldier living in Palestine in the beginning of the 4th century. Martyred in Lydda, a town in Israel, in the year 304, there were churches in England dedicated to him before the Norman conquest. George replaced Edward the Confessor as patron saint of England following the crusades.

25: Mark the evangelist: John Mark was a Jew and a cousin to Barnabus. He travelled extensively on missionary work to Cyprus and Rome, accompanying Barnabus, Paul and Peter. His gospel was probably the first to be written, and has a particularly sharp focus about it.

We do not have an exact date in the year to celebrate the life of **Saint Elbod**, but as it is still the season of Easter, we have included him at this time. St. Elbod's Church in Rhos y Gaer Ave, Holyhead, although now demolished, holds fond memories for many of our congregation. Elbod, Elbodius or Elfodd, was a Bishop of Bangor, Archbishop of Gwynedd, who died in 809 AD.

As a young man, he appears to have been associated with the monastery at Holyhead and must have still been comparatively young when in 768 he persuaded the Welsh church to come into line with Rome as regards the method of calculating the date of Easter. His pupils described him as a 'most holy bishop'
