Saints Days May 2016

01: Philip and James—Apostles: They are both listed as part of the twelve in the first three gospels, but John gives Philip greater prominence. He features in the feeding of the five thousand, and also at the last supper. James, sometimes called the less or the younger, was believed to be the son of Alphaeus. According to Mark, his mother was a witness at the crucifixion.

05: Asaph—Bishop: When St Kentigern founded a monastic settlement on the banks of the River Elwy in North Wales, one of his pupils was a nobly born boy named Asaph. When Kentigern was called to become Bishop of Glasgow, Asaph was appointed Bishop of Llanelwy (now St Asaph.) He remained there for the rest of his life and was buried there.

14: Mathias—Apostle: After Judas Iscariot left the group, Mathias was chosen by lot to replace him from amongst the disciples who had been with Jesus during his earthly ministry, and had witnessed the resurrection. Being chosen by lot indicated that he had been chosen by God rather than by men.
