Jane Leadbetter of the National Messy Church team will be helping us

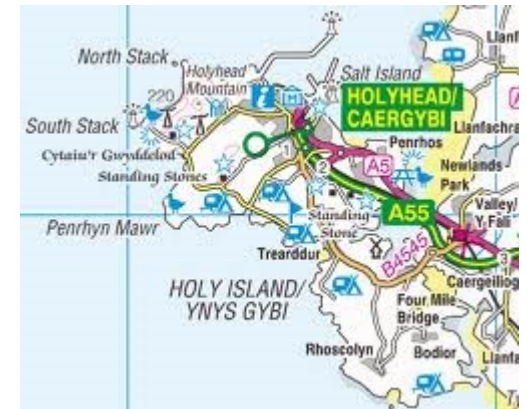
